Vacation Fund Deduction

Article III, Section 3.07 The Employer agrees to deduct vacation deductions in the amount specified upon receipt of a suitable written authorization form provided for that purpose by the Union. Authorization for deductions shall be available to employees at any time; however, changes to such authorizations shall be permitted only on June 1 or December 1 of each year.

All such deductions shall be mailed once per month, along with a suitable payroll report showing the deductions for each employee, to reach the Board 63 Collection Account Trust not later than 15 calendar days following the end of the month. (See Article 6.08).

This authorization is voluntarily made based on my specific understanding that:

- The signing of this authorization card and the making of these voluntary contributions are not conditions of membership in the union or of employment by my employer;
- That I may refuse to contribute without reprisal;
- Authorization for deduction shall be available to employees at any time, however, designed amounts to be deducted shall be changed only on the dates of June 1 and December 1 of each year.
